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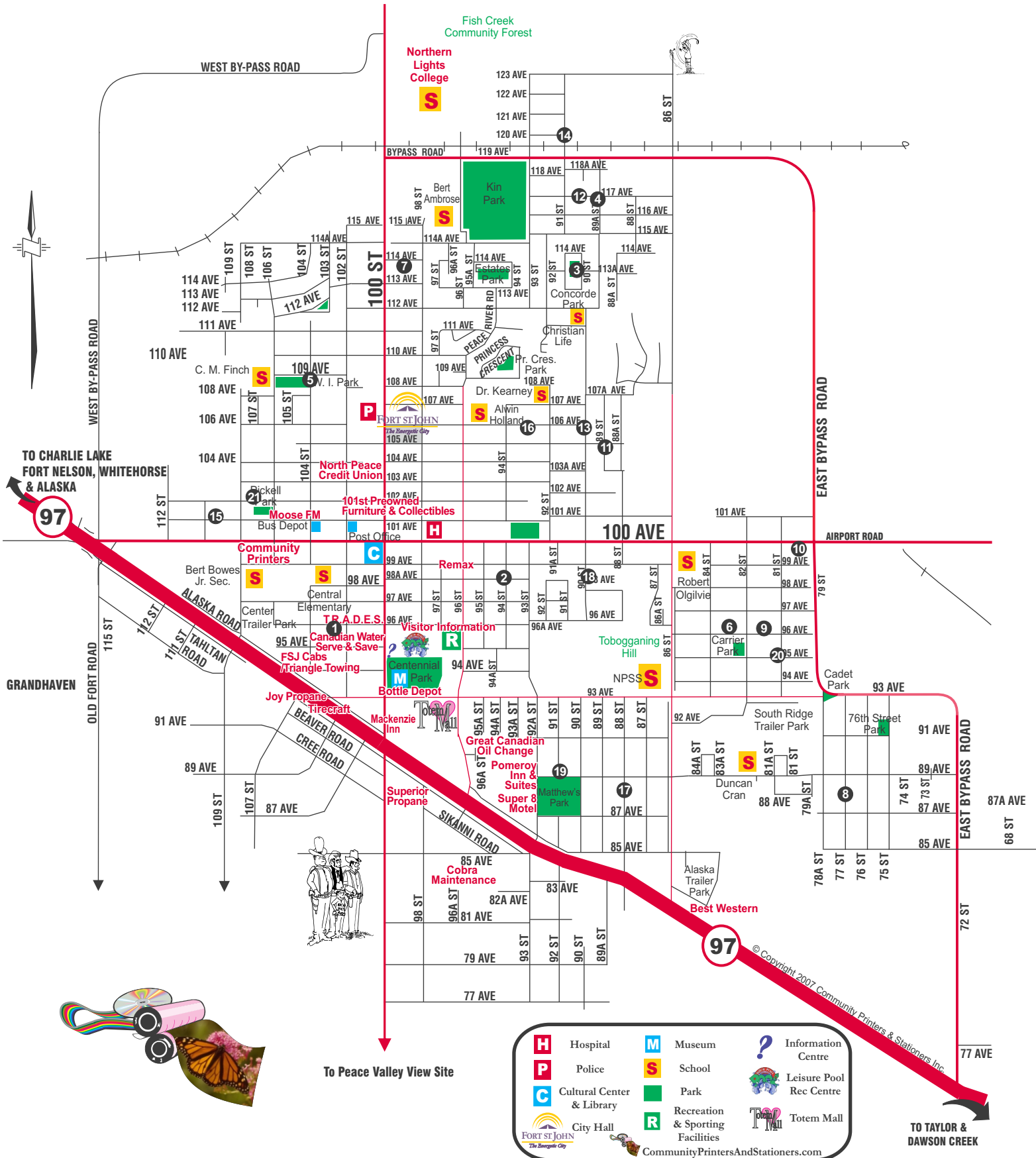

A man was speeding down the highway, feeling secure in a group of cars all traveling at the same


